Lumana's programs include holistic financial services such as microloans and savings accounts, as well as leadership development and business education. We are currently located in the Volta Region of rural Ghana.

Our Fellowship program enables aspiring young people to travel to Ghana and work in the field, expanding and strengthening our operations. Previous fellows have worked on a variety of projects ranging from local business industry research, to development of new financial products for our clients, to capturing media, and more.

We aren't looking for students of a specific major or young professionals of a certain vocation, but rather for self-motivated, competent, and passionate individuals who can work effectively in unstructured and resource-poor settings.

There are Fellows trips available during the spring and summer of 2012, each lasting approximately 8 weeks; the estimated dates of these are as follows:
